

Overseas CRB Checks



The CRB can only access the criminal records (convictions, cautions, reprimands and warnings) held on the Police National Computer (PNC) in England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.

Details of alternative documentation you can provide in place of a CRB is listed below for several countries:

Australia

Individuals can obtain information from their authorities

Austria

The Austrian local police or council offices issue a 'good conduct' certificate

Belgium

Certificates of 'good conduct' can be obtained from the Communes (certificate de bonnes vies et moeurs)

Denmark

The local police issue a 'good conduct' certificate

France

Contact the French National Criminal Records Office either online, in person or via an application form - www.cjn.justice.gouv.fr

Germany

The Federal Central Register issues a 'good conduct' certificate

Greece

Criminal record information can be obtained from the Public Prosecutor

Netherlands

Certificates of 'good conduct' can be obtained from the Burgemeister

Spain

Certificates of 'good standing' can be obtained from the Ministry of Justice

Switzerland

Criminal record information can be obtained from the Swiss Police

Return evidence of a clean criminal record e.g. Public Prosecutor statement (original copy with a notarised translation into English)
